Throughout early April in 1918 Australian units helped defend Villers-Bretonneux from this onslaught, but at dawn on the 24th the Germans attacked and captured the town. Leading the British counter attack, the Australian 13th and 15th Brigades enveloped the town and successfully cleared it of Germans on the 25th of April, the third anniversary of the Anzac landings at Gallipoli.





- 8 April A referendum is held in Western Australia, which is carried 2 to 1 in favour of secession from the Commonwealth of Australia.
- 26 April The seaplane carrier, HMAS Albatross, is paid off into reserve.
- 10 June The Australian Women's Weekly is first published.
- 13 June The Australian Antarctic Territory is established.
- 28 August The Brisbane newspaper, The Courier-Mail, is first published.
- 5 September Australia signs a trade agreement with New Zealand.
- 6 September Windscreen wipers become compulsory on all Australian cars.
- 13 October The first traffic lights in Sydney become operational at the intersection of Kent and Market Streets.

1914 ANZAC BISCUITS

First judged in 1981 Makes: 40-50 biscuits

90 g (6% oz/2 cups) rolled oats 50 g (5% oz/1 cup) plain flour 65 g (5% oz/% cup) sugar 25 g (4% oz) butter, cubed

1 large rounded tablespoon golden syru 1 teaspoon bicarbonate of soda

2 tablespoons hot water


Preheat oven to 160°C (315°F/Gas 2-3). Grease two baking trays.

Mix together the oats, flour and sugar in a bowl. Melt the butter and golden syrup together, add bicarbonate of soda dissolved in the hot water. Pour into the dry ingredients and mix well.

Roll into balls the size of a walnut (or a 10-cent piece) and place on the prepared trays. Bake for about 20 minutes until golden. Move biscuit registrons while hot. Allow to cool and crisp on tray.
