



# WHAT IS THE ISSUE?

- THE VICTORIAN VETERANS COUNCIL'S <u>VETERANS STUDY REPORT</u> FOUND THE VETERAN
  COMMUNITY IS CHANGING AND A RETHINK REGARDING SUPPORT STRATEGIES WAS
  NEEDED. THE STUDY FOUND THAT ALTHOUGH MANY VETERANS TRANSITION TO CIVILIAN
  LIFE WITH MINIMAL DISRUPTION, SOME DO EXPERIENCE ISSUES INCLUDING ISOLATION,
  MENTAL HEALTH PROBLEMS AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE.
- FOR MANY YOUNG VETERANS, THE PHYSICAL AND EMOTIONAL ADJUSTMENT TO CIVILIAN LIFE IS EXTREMELY DIFFICULT AND CAN LEAD TO DEVELOPING OR WORSENING OF SERIOUS MENTAL HEALT DIFFICULTIES







I was just roaming around the internet and found this, though you also might find it interesting.......For many years the Australian Army has tested vehicles at Monegeetta proving grounds. Photos stretching back as far as World War Two show vehicles being tested to destruction there......enjoy



An overview of Monegeetta proving grounds. The centre is the

administration area with the reacks in the surrounding areas.



No explanation needed.

This MKP Bedford is on an 11 km stretch of second class road which has corrugations, pot holes and a range of gradients and turns ranging from gentle to severe. It us one way.



Gradients: The ability to negotiate a grade of 60% of 1:1/76

(about 31 degrees) is required of GS vehicles.




Sand & Mud. Pits are 24m square, and 1.4m deep. One is sand, one is mud. This tests the mobility of vehicles in straight line and continuous figure eight patterns.

Turns, winching, residual draw bar tractive effort, tyre aggressiveness and track treads patterns with and without trailers are tested.

Another Ramp over Shot Ser 2a

Tilt table: Used to measure roll over angle on a dry smooth surface and show any fuel & oil leaks. And engine stability at angles.

Ramp over angle testing: Used to test vehicle ability to negotiate exit and entry ramps of landing craft in extreme conditions.





test: side by side/ up down profile of blocks determines whether mobility can be maintained without damage to steering, brakes and suspension. Depression and bumps are 150mm, total 300mm.





Deep fording pool: Length, 12m Water depth, up to 2.4m. Entry and exit ramps of 1.4 and 1.2 to simulate steep river banks or ramps on landing craft etc. Used to determine fording capabilities and flotation abilities and characteristics of vehicle













### **HISTORY**

The Post Office opened on 23 January 1911 as Monegatta South, was renamed Monegeeta (sic) in 1917 then Monegeetta around 1960 and closed in 1992. Another office nearby, Duck Holes, had opened in 1866, was renamed Monegatta in 1875, North Monegeeta in 1917, North Monegeetta around 1961 and closed in 1969.[2]

Monegeetta North, occasionally referred to as Duckholes, was historically a distinct locality, once featuring its own Hotel (1862-1896) and State school (1868-1903). The former Hotel building remains as a local landmark for travellers on the Melbourne-Lancefield Road.[3]

Both Monegeetta and North Monegeetta were stopping points on the Clarkefield-Lancefield railway.

### **TODAY**

Monegeetta features Mintaro Homestead (1882), a smaller replica of Melbourne's Government House built by a Captain Gardiner.

The Land Engineering Agency (LEA) of the Australian Department of Defence operates a heavy vehicle testing course near the town.

The town contains a CFA fire station and general store, and a private bus company operates a commuter bus service to Melbourne for residents from Monday to Friday.
