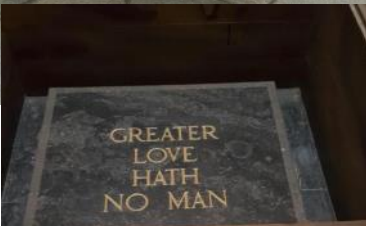

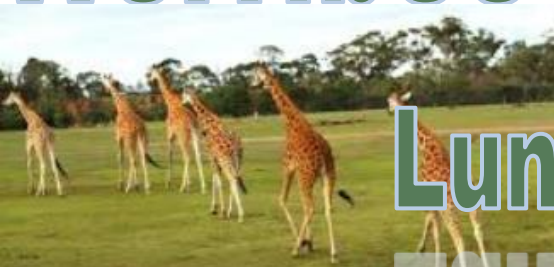

MAY: On an airmail flight to New Zealand, "Southern Cross" piloted by Kingsford Smith develops engine trouble, and G. Taylor climbs out under the wing to transfer oil from one engine to the other for which he is awarded the Empire Gallantry Medal (later the George Cross).

OCTOBER: BHP & Australian Iron & Steel merge and become an industrial monopoly.



R.G. Whitehead develops Tarzans Grip Glue

Luna Park in Sydney is officially opened.
