Sausage and potato tray bake





500g baby white potatoes 560g Australian Pork Chipolatas 2 red onions, cut into wedges 250g vine-ripened cherry tomatoes 60g pkt Australian Baby Rocket Spicy salsa verde 1 tsp ground cumin

1/2 tsp ground coriander 1 cup basil leaves

1/2 cup flat-leaf parsley leaves

1/4 cup mint leaves

1/4 cup oregano leaves

1 long red chilli, seeded, finely chopped

1 garlic clove, finely chopped

2 tbsp malt vinegar

1/3 cup (80ml) olive oil



METHOD

Step 1

Preheat oven to 220C. Place the potatoes in a large baking tray and spray with olive oil spray. Season. Bake for 30 mins or until potatoes are just tender. Remove from oven.

Step 2

Use a clean tea towel to lightly crush potatoes. Spray with olive oil spray. Arrange the sausages and onion around the potatoes on the tray. Bake, turning occasionally, for 20 mins. Arrange the tomatoes over the tray. Bake for 15 mins or until the sausages are golden brown and cooked through.

Step 3

Meanwhile, to make the spicy salsa verde, toast the cumin and coriander in a small saucepan over medium heat for 1 min or until aromatic. Transfer to a food processor. Add the basil, parsley, mint, oregano, chilli and garlic and process until finely chopped. Add the vinegar and oil and process until well combined. Season.

Step 4

Drizzle salsa verde evenly over the sausages and vegetables on the tray. Serve sprinkled with rocket.












